Policy relating to the processing of personal data implemented in the context of Bpifrance's Financing activity

1. WHO IS THIS POLICY FOR?

This policy (the **"Policy")** is intended for all persons whose data is processed by Bpifrance in the context of its financing activities:

- Innovation funding;
- Financing of the treasury;
- Financing of assets and intangibles (short-term financing);
- Financing of energy/environment projects.

You are covered by this Policy if you are ("You"):

- Legal representative, authorised person, project manager, point of contact, beneficial owner or shareholder/partner in a company that Bpifrance plans to finance/support or any other person whose data collection is necessary for the investigation of a transaction (hereinafter the "Prospect");
- Legal representative, authorised person, project manager, point of contact, beneficial owner or shareholder/partner in a company financed and/or supported by Bpifrance (i.e. with which Bpifrance has concluded an aid contract or a loan contract) or any other person whose data collection is necessary for the investigation of an operation and its follow-up (hereinafter the "Financed Company");
- Any other person whose data collection is strictly necessary for Bpifrance in the context of the examination of an application or the follow-up of a file, and in particular any guarantors and/or operational contacts.

When you provide personal data relating to other persons, it is your responsibility to duly inform these persons of the transmission of their data to Bpifrance and to make available to them the information contained in this Policy.

2. WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROCESSING CARRIED OUT?

Bpifrance, 27-31 avenue du Général Leclerc 94 710 Maisons-Alfort, is deemed to act as a data controller (the **"Company**") when it processes your personal data for the purposes detailed below.

3. WHAT DATA DOES BPIFRANCE PROCESS, FOR WHAT PURPOSES AND FOR HOW LONG IS THIS DATA KEPT?

In accordance with the applicable regulations, in particular European Regulation 2016/679, known as the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the national provisions relating to information technology, files and freedoms (hereinafter the Applicable Regulation), Bpifrance, as data controller, collects and processes your personal data for the purposes listed below.

Bpifrance retains your personal data for the time necessary to implement the purposes set out and applies the retention periods below.

Please note that, in accordance with the principle of minimisation, Bpifrance only collects the personal data it needs for the above-mentioned purposes.

When you do not provide the personal data identified as mandatory, Bpifrance will not be able to carry out its activities and carry out the financing.

4. HOW IS YOUR PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED?

Your personal data is collected by Bpifrance directly from you or from a third party who has duly informed you of the transmission of your information to Bpifrance.

In some cases, Bpifrance also collects personal data about you indirectly from:

- Other Bpifrance entities in compliance with legal, regulatory or contractual confidentiality obligations that apply to third parties;
- Any other funder/funder, in particular the State, within the framework of the financing mechanisms implemented by Bpifrance;
- Bpifrance partners in charge of all or part of the scheme to which you are applying ;(please refer to the documentation for your scheme);
- Databases made available by authorities or official third parties (e.g. the Official Journal of the French Republic, the Trade and Companies Register, databases managed by banking supervisory authorities);
- IT service providers whose solution integrates a database containing information about you.

In these cases, Bpifrance ensures that the indirect collection of your data is carried out in accordance with the requirements of the GDPR.

5. TO WHOM IS YOUR PERSONAL DATA DISCLOSED?

Your data is intended for Bpifrance and will also be communicated:

- To the other entities of the Bpifrance group, as soon as this transmission is necessary to enable these entities to meet their legal or regulatory obligations or to ensure the deployment of the proposed system. This transmission of intra-group information does not in any way exempt the entities of the Bpifrance group from the legal, regulatory or contractual confidentiality obligations that apply to them with regard to third parties;
- Partner banks involved in the financing operation when Bpifrance acts as lead bank;
- To the professional advisors (advisors, experts, law firms) and auditors of Bpifrance,
- Where applicable, to the State and the services attached, to other donors, to local authorities, and/or to the European Commission;
- The partners involved in the financing mechanism concerned;
- IT service providers, or any other service provider (including lawyers and experts who give an opinion on a project that has been the subject of a request for financing) or subcontractors providing services in connection with all or part of the processing identified above on behalf of Bpifrance;
- Service providers in charge of evaluating the financing mechanism concerned (including external expertise and audits);
- To any French or European administrative, judicial or supervisory authority that needs to be aware of it in the context of an administrative or judicial procedure that benefits from a right of communication based on a legislative or regulatory provision.



To the relevant tax authorities, for the purposes of complying with our legal obligations.

Bpifrance is committed to limiting the transfer of personal data outside the European Union. When such transfers are to be implemented, Bpifrance relies on the following to carry out these transfers:

- A decision issued by the European Commission, attesting to the level of adequacy of the regulations of the country to which your data is transferred;
- One of the derogations provided for by the GDPR (in particular when the transfers are implemented because they are necessary for the conclusion or performance of a contract concluded in your interest between Bpifrance and the legal person to which you are linked);

In other cases, Bpifrance ensures that the transfer is supervised in accordance with the GDPR and implements appropriate guarantees with regard to the protection of personal data, by means of legal, technical and organizational measures.

6. WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS?

In accordance with the Applicable Regulations, and subject to the conditions set out therein for the exercise of these rights, you benefit from:

- The right to access, rectify, delete, and portability of your personal data.
- The right to request the limitation of the processing concerning you and to object to receiving commercial prospecting.
- The ability to provide Bpifrance with instructions relating to the fate of his or her personal data after your death.

To exercise your rights, you can contact the data protection officer of the Bpifrance group, using the contact details provided in Section 7 ("*How to contact Bpifrance?*") below.

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Commission Nationale de l'Informatique et des Libertés (CNIL).
